Professional Development & Education

- October 2022 July 2023 Commencement of the *Interdisciplinary Rehabilitation Fellowship (IRF)*
 - 10 month hybrid post-professional program we co-founded with AASMC, in partnership with NIH Armenia, Polaris Educorp, and HENAR
 - o Sponsored by Armenian American Medical Society, Glendale Memorial
 - 28 fellows (24 from Armenia, 4 from Artsakh) from occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech language pathology, and medical backgrounds have graduated from the accredited program
 - All fellows completed capstone projects on the following topics:
 Home Health Rehabilitation, Experiences with the ICF model,
 Prevalence of Pressure Ulcers in Artsakh, Telerehabilitation,
 Professional Development of Speech Therapists, Rehabilitation in Emergencies
 - TFA sponsored one fellow to attend and present a poster at the 6th International Medical Congress of Armenia (6IMCA)
 - TFA members, Jennifer Thompson and Lusine Karapetyan were clinical instructors of the orthopedic / prosthetics module (December 2022);
 Adrineh Mehdikhani hosted a Tai Chi Workshop in Yerevan during the final session; Armineh Babikian taught modules on cognitive evaluations and adaptive equipment, and mentored 10 IRF fellows in their capstone projects related to qualitative research and advocacy

- June & July, 2023 TFA Supports Gyumri's First Inclusive Playground
 - In June, TFA was awarded a Birthright Alumni microgrant in collaboration with the Emili Aregak Center to get sensory equipment for Gyumri's first inclusive playground.
 - This playground will have wheelchair accessible swings, elevated sand boxes, a trampoline, sensory stations, and more. It will be a safe space for all children to explore and play together.
 - In July, TFA visited this space to overview the project
 - In September, the rubber ground was laid and benches were donated. Soon, the trampoline will be installed.

- October 2023 TFA creates first Armenian Language Rehab Resources for Artsakh Burn Victims
 - TFA has translated resources related to burn care rehabilitation including occupational and physiotherapy approaches, stretches, exercises, and scar massage techniques. These will help to maintain muscle integrity, increase range of motions, and decrease the appearance of scars.
- October 2023 Donation of over 200 Burn Rehab equipment to National Burn Center (Yerevan)
 - TFA was the only diaspora health organization providing support for rehabilitation needs working in collaboration with the staff at the National Burn Center. The following equipment was donated as per the center's request for high-demand needs:
 - 83 Compression gloves
 - 50 Compression socks
 - 15 Packs of silicone scar gel
 - 10 Post-surgery face masks
 - 50 hydrocolloid wound dressings
 - 12 rolls of silicone scar sheets
 - Shoulder abduction brace
 - Hinged knee brace
 - 2 Ankle Foot Orthoses (AFO)
 - Back Brace

Fundraising
